#### A. Preamble

To reward research achievements and foster well-resourced research environment, King Fahd University of Petroleum & Minerals shall give two (2) awards annually to its faculty/researcher that have achieved excellence in applied research on a University-wide basis. The deadline for submission of nominations will be announced by the Deanship of Research Oversight and Coordination (DROC).

### B. Eligibility

A faculty or researcher who, at the time of the award, has four or more calendar years of continuous service to KFUPM (including sabbatical leave and official assignments) or a total of six calendar years of service with no more than a total of 12-months interruption in service is eligible to apply for the award based on their performance in client/external funded projects. A candidate may receive the award only once during his entire service at the University.

#### C. Criteria for Award

The main criterion for the award shall be the magnitude, quality and significance of research accomplished in client-funded, or externally funded, research activities as evidenced by funding secured, timely completion of project objectives, and research outcomes such as publications and patents. In addition, honors/awards, membership on the editorial boards of journals, invitation to deliver keynote speeches, contributions to the preparation of proposals, reports, and technical memoranda shall be considered in evaluating the candidate.

### D. Nominations and Selection for the Award

- 1. Center Director may submit a maximum of two (2) nominations for the award based on the performance in client/external funded project
- 2. Ad-hoc committee (Committee for Applied Research Awards) evaluate applications and select a maximum of three (3) nominations within two weeks of its formation and forward the nominations to the University Research Committee (RC).
- 3. Recommendations from the RC with the best two (2) are forwarded to Chairman, Scientific Council for final approval.

#### E. Benefits

The award winner receives SR. 5,000 as cash prize, certification, and a plaque.
